

How to connect to our WiFi on your Android phone or tablet

Did you know that as an East Kent Colleges Group student, you have access to our WiFi for all your own devices, while studying at our campuses?

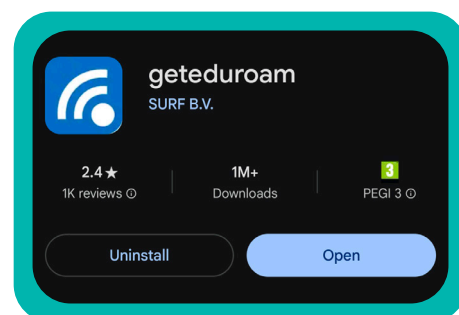
You also have access to WiFi anywhere that supports eduroam, like most universities, and some hospitals. Simply follow this quick guide to connect.

Note:

You will require pre-existing internet access to connect. Please either use your mobile data, or follow these steps at home - you will then automatically connect on campus.

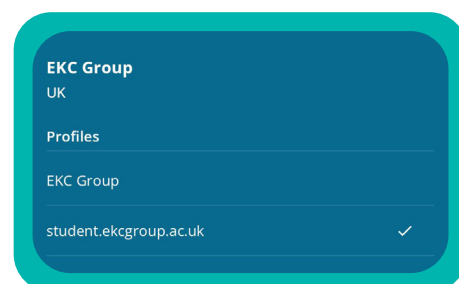
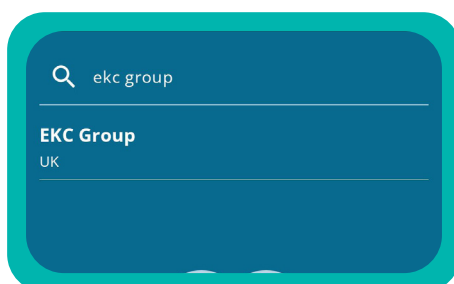
Step 01:

Begin by downloading the 'geteduroam' app from the Play Store, and opening the app.



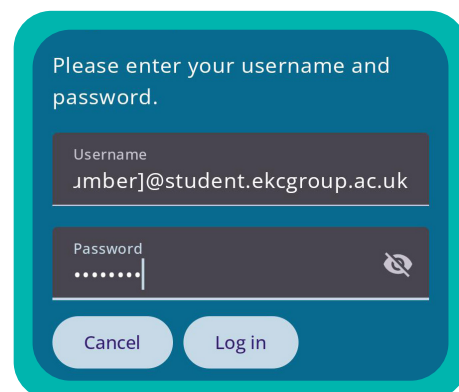
Step 02:

Once in the app, search for EKC Group, and select it once it appears. Next, select the 'student.ekcgroup.ac.uk' profile and press 'connect' at the bottom of the screen.



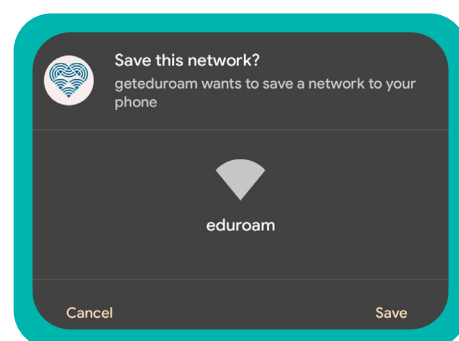
Step 03:

Next, you'll be asked to enter your login details. This will be your student number, followed by @student.ekcgroup.ac.uk. If you can't remember it, you can find your student number at the bottom of your ID card. Your password will be the same one you use to log into College computers.



Step 04:

Once you've pressed log in, you will see a pop-up. Click 'save' in the bottom right hand corner, and you will be connected!
