

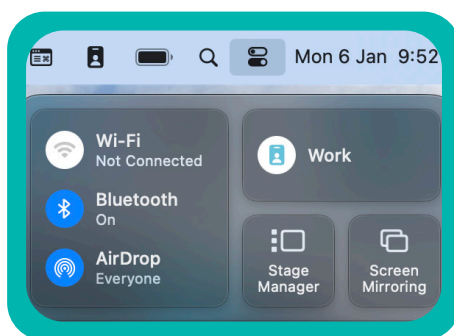
How to connect to our WiFi on your MacBook

Did you know that as an East Kent Colleges Group student, you have access to our WiFi for all your own devices, while studying at our campuses?

You also have access to WiFi anywhere that supports eduroam, like most universities, and some hospitals. Simply follow this quick guide to connect.

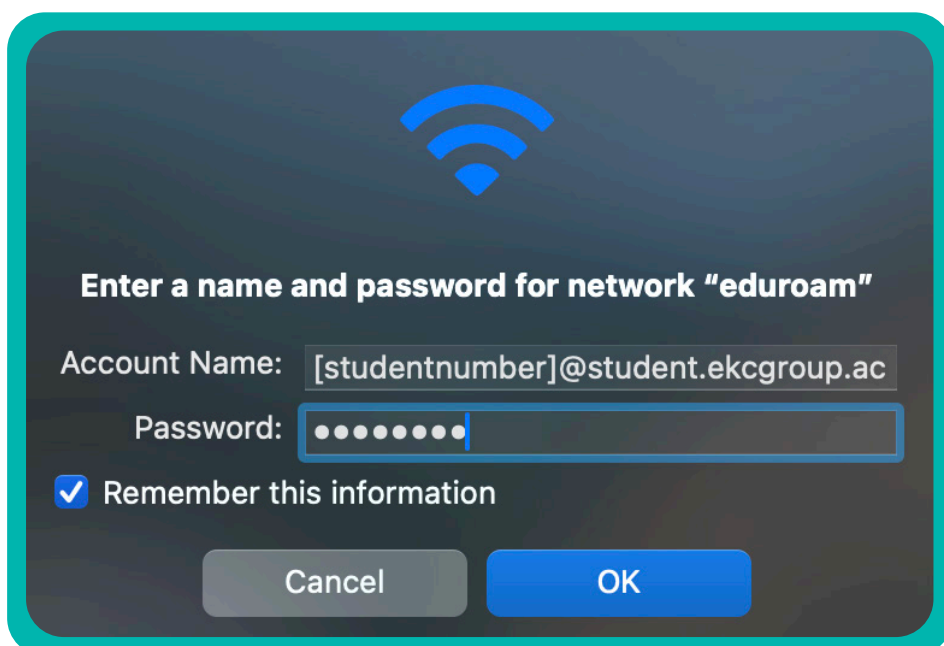
Step 01:

Navigate to your device's WiFi settings, by clicking the control panel icon, and then WiFi. Then select the network called "eduroam".



Step 02:

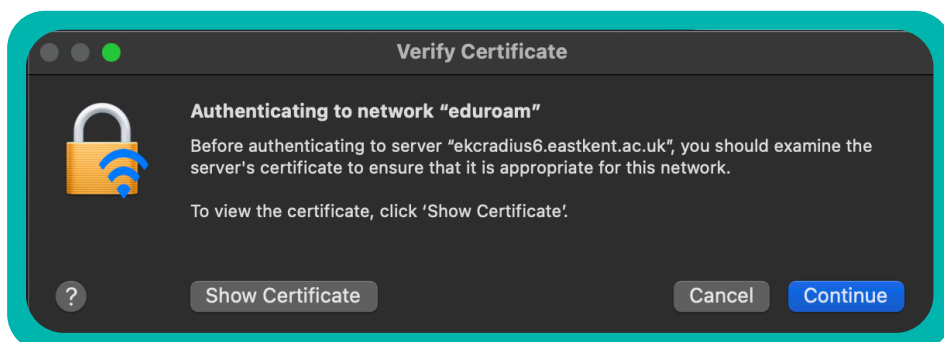
Input your username and password. This will be your student number, followed by @student.ekcgroup.ac.uk. If you can't remember it, you can find your student number at the bottom of your ID card. Your password will be the same one you use to log into College computers.



Step 03:

Once you've pressed join, you will see a pop-up. Click 'continue' in the bottom right hand corner, and you will be connected!
