How to calculate your GPA

To calculate your GPA, take your top six predicted grades, add the numbers together and divide by six.

For example, if you are predicted a 8 in Maths, 6 in Geography, 7 in English Language, 5 in Media Studies, 6 in Art, and 6 in English Literature, you would add the grades together: $8+6+7+5+6+6 = 38$. You would then divide the total by six to get a GPA of 6.3.
